

One way to support Canadian Content creators would be to include their e-books in the Public Lending Rights program which provides a small remuneration for creators whose works are made available in public libraries. For years, libraries across Canada have been including ebooks by Canadian creators in their collections and yet they have not paid a single cent to the creators of the ebooks, while they have been paying a small tithe to those same creators whose books they circulate in hard copy format. There is no excuse for this - ebooks are the same as any other book with ISBN and the creators should be respected by the Canadian Government through the Heritage Ministry which oversees the Public Lending Rights Commission
